General Membership Meeting Minutes

- Call Meeting to Order:** President Colleen Dubsy welcomed all members to our meeting.
- Reading of Minutes:** Renee Stouffer read the minutes of the last meeting on November 17, 2012. A motion was made by Caren Miille to accept the minutes as read. Mindy Kerwin seconded the motion.
- Treasurer's Report:** Lindsey Pinkham-Heiden presented the treasurer's report. The Pinnacle Bank account has a balance of \$30,954.01. \$25,176.06 is currently set up in a money market account with the remaining balance of \$3,885.13 in a regular checking account.
- A motion was made by Jean Adams to accept the treasurer's report. Courtney Lutjelusche seconded the motion.
- Directory:** The directories have been mailed out to our members. Some directories were taken to the Holiday Classic horse show in Oklahoma City and also to the Western Stock show in Denver. Jean Adams has volunteered to take some directories to the No Bulls Just Horses Expo in March.
- The directories made a net profit of \$6,86.45.
- Newsletter:** Mindy Kerwin will be creating the newsletter.
- Website:** Lindsey Pinkham-Heiden maintains the website.
- Youth:** No information was available.
- 2013 Shows:** Exhibitors will be required to volunteer their time at the horse shows in order to qualify for year end awards. Lindsey Pinkham-Heiden will set up a spreadsheet to keep track of who has completed their time.
- Show fees will remain the same as 2012 with the exception of lowering the youth walk/trot fee and adding a yearling division fee. The April show fees will increase due to adding two judges to the show.
- The board has decided to drop the goat tying classes from all of our shows. The cost of maintaining a goat outweighed the number of people who exhibit the classes.
- Roping classes have been added to the March show. Hunter Hack classes have been added to the April show.
- For the September show only, the club will award double state points for one judge per day.
- There will be a total of 24 judges to show to for the year. An exhibitor must show to a minimum of 13 judges for year end awards.
- Jackie McGinnis from APHA will be coming to our April show to participate in the youth club's Celebrity Goat Tying. She will take pictures at our show and print them in the Paint Horse Journal.
- The club will be offering some incentives for the April show.
- 1 - Stall fee will be \$100 for the entire show
  - 2 - Club members will receive a \$25 credit for coming to the show on Thursday instead Wednesday
  - 3 - Club members will receive participation points - 1 per judge - that will be applied towards state points.
- Holman Photography will be taking pictures at our April show.
