


ALL RANCH TRAIL

- 1. Walk Bridge
- 2. Walk Over Poles
- 3. Lope the Right Lead Over Poles & Into Chute
- 4. Back the "L"
- 5. Trot the Poles
- 6. Left Hand Push Gate
- Leit Hand Push Gate
 Walk to Pole & Sidepass Right Over the Pole & Pivot Right 1/2 Turn
 Walk to Carry/Drag—Walk/Trot, Youth & Novice will Carry Object Amateur & Open will Drag Object Around the Standard & Return to Standard, (Walk Or Trot Optional) Walk out to finish






All In-Hand Trail and Walk Trot Classes 10-25



- WORK GATE LEFT HAND.
- 2. YOU MAY WALK FORWARD, THEN JOG UP TO FIRST SET OF POLES, STOP OR BREAK TO THE WALK, WALK OVER POLES, THEN JOG UP TO SECOND SET OF POLES, STOP OR BREAK TO THE WALK, WALK OVER POLES.
- 3. JOG OVER POLES, JOG INTO CHUTE AND STOP.
- 4. BACK BETWEEN POLES, BACK AROUND CORNER, WALK OUT OVER POLES.
- 5. JOG OVER POLES.
- 6. JOG THROUGH SERPENTINE, JOG OVER POLES.
- 7. STOP OR BREAK TO THE WALK, WALK OVER POLES.
- 8. WALK INTO BOX, EXECUTE A 360 TURN EITHER WAY, WALK OUT BOX.





- 1. WORK GATE LEFT HAND.

- 3. BREAK TO THE JOG, JOG OVER POLES.

- 8. BREAK TO THE JOG, JOG THROUGH SERPENTINE, JOG OVER POLES.
- 9. STOP OR BREAK TO THE WALK, WALK OVER POLES.
- 10. WALK INTO BOX, EXECUTE A 360 TURN EITHER WAY, WALK OUT BOX.


All distances are approximated and are only recommendations Pattern may be set clockwise or



- 4. Extended trot

- 7. Lope right lead
- 8. Extended lope right lead
- 9.Collect lope, change leads (simple or flying), continue lope
- 10. Walk
- 11.Lope left lead
- 12.Extended trot
- 13. Trot
- 14.Stop and back



- 8. WALK OVER POLES
- 9.STOP/ BACK 1 Horse Length



Ranch Reining Classes 73-75




Ride pattern as follows: Trot to center of arena and stop or walk before departure. Start pattern facing toward judge.

- 1. Beginning on right lead, lope one circle to the right. Change leads at center of arena.
- center of arena.
 2.Complete one circle to the left. Change leads at center of arena.
- 3.Begin a circle to the right, but do not close this circle. Run down center of arena, past the end marker, and do a sliding stop.
- 4. Complete 3 1/2 spins to the right.
- 5. Run up to other end of arena, past the end marker, do a sliding stop.
- 6.Complete 3 1/2 spins to the left.
- 7.Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back at least 10 feet. Hesitate to show completion pattern.





- Walk, transition to jog, jog over log
 Transition to the right lead and lope around end
 First line change
- 4. Second line change, lope around end of arena
 5. First crossing change
 6. Second crossing change

- 7. Third crossing change
- 8. Lope over log
- 9. Lope, stop & back




- 1. Walk, transition to jog, jog over log.
- 2. Transition to right.
- 3. First line change.
- 4. Second line change.
- 5. Third line change.
- 6. Fourth line change.
- 7. First crossing change.
- 8. Second crossing change.
- 9. Third crossing change.
- 10. Lope over log.
- 11. Lope, stop and back.



Ranch Horsemanship Class 81-84




- 1.Starting at A, lope right lead.
- 2.Below B, break to the walk
- 3.Lope left lead around B
- 4. When crossing your path, break to the jog
- 5.At C, stop and back
- 6.Perform a 360° turn left.
- 7.Extend the jog past your path making a rightturn as shown
- 8. When opposite B, stop and perform a 1800 right.
- 9.Exit the pattern at the jog

Be ready at A.

- Lope on the right lead from A to B.
- 2. Break to a jog at B and jog a circle to the left.
- 3. Stop at B.
- 4. Back one horse length at B.
- 5. Extend the jog to C.
- 6. Stop at C.








- 1. At A, extend the jog to C
- 2. Stop at C and perform a 270° turn right.
- 3. Jog a half circle to B
- 4. At B, walk 4 or 5 steps
- 5. Stop and back to B
- 6. Jog to the exit, making a right turn when well past B, as shown






Horsemanship Classes 239-243




- 1. Lope right lead to C
- 2. At C, perform a 180 turn to the right and jog to B
- 3. At B, stop and back 4 to 5 steps
- 4. Perform a 270 turn and lope a left lead half circle to B
- 5. Break to the walk for 4 or 5 steps
- 6. Extend the jog, performing a square corner when well past B, as shown.
- 7. Exit the pattern at the extended jog




- 1. Be ready at A
- 2. Trot to C
- 3. At C, stop and perform a 180 degree turn
- 4. Walk forward 4 to 5 steps
- 5. Stop and back 4 to 5 steps
- 6. Trot a half circle to the judge
- 7. Stop and set up for inspection
- 8. When dismissed, perform a 180 degree turn
- 9. Trot. Once past B, walk to the exit





Walk Trot Showmanship Classes 253-261

Amateurs will walk where trot is indicated



- 1. Trot A to B.
- 2. Stop at B.
- 3. Back halfway to A.
- 4. Perform a 270 degree turn .
- Walk to the judge, stop and set up for inspection.
- 6. When dismissed, perform a 90 degree turn and trot away from judge.






Western Showmanship




- 1. Be ready at A

- 4 Walk forward 4 to 5 steps
- 5 Stop and back 4 to 5 steps
- 6. Trot a half circle to the judge
- 7 Stop and set up for inspection
- 8 When dismissed, perform a 180 degree turn
- 9. Trot. Once past B, walk to the exit





English Showmanship Classes 274-275



Be ready at A


- 1. When acknowledged, trot from A, around B and to C
- 2. Walk a tight circle around C
- 3. Trot to judge
- 4. Back approximately one horse lengh
- 5. Walk to judge
- 6. Stop and set up
- 7. for inspection
- 8. When dismissed, perform a 270 turn and walk away from judge


Be ready before A

- 1. Walk to A
- 2. Trot left diagonal to B
- 3. Canter right lead to C
- 4. Trot right diagonal halfway to D
- 5. Sitting trot to D
- 6. Stop and back approximately one horse length

English Equitation Classes 311-317




Be ready at A

- 1. Walk halfway to B
- 2. Sitting trot to B
- 3. Trot on the left diagonal from B, to and around C, and halfway to A
- 4. Change diagonals halfway to A
- 5. Trot on the right diagonal around A and to D
- 6. Stop at D and back approximately one horse length



English Equitation Classes 325-329



Be ready before A

- 1. Walk to A
- 2. Sitting trot 1/2 way to B
- 3. Posting trot on the left diagonal to B
- 4. Canter on the left lead toward C
- 5. At the top of the arc, change leads and canter on the right lead to C
- 6. Posting trot on the right diagonal 1/2 way to D
- 7. Sitting trot to D
- 8. Halt at D and back approximately one horse length
- 9. Exit at a sitting trot
